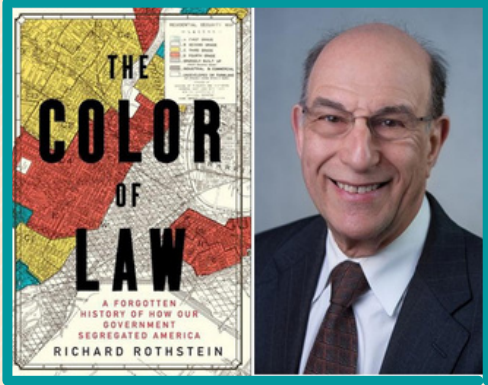


The Color of Law:
